Summer Assignment for Portfolio Prep

Portfolio students are required to gather ALL their artwork work and bring it in to school for documentation and portfolio creation. (Strong creative work that has been made in other classes—particularly CIS classes—can also be included.) Students do not need to bring in their physical work if they already have proper documentation, but students do need to bring the documentation. In addition, all students must come up with 3 fleshed out project ideas for the start of class. Students should be excited and ready to work on these projects.

For students who need a portfolio for their applications, they are also required to complete 1 observational drawing. This drawing should be done from life, with a light source. The drawing should be finished, polished and ready for display. If you need drawing supplies, please contact Ms. Henderson. It is also highly encouraged for students to create a piece on their own during the summer. Full portfolios require at 10-15 high quality pieces, so the more you can begin to accomplish over the summer, the easier your school year will be.
