Summer Reading Assignment 2017 English 10 World Literature Ms. Bentley Hoke

Hello Class of 2020! I hope you're enjoying your summer. In preparation for English 10 World Literature, you will be choosing a summer reading selection from the books below:

Life of Pi by Yann Martel
The Kite Runner by Khaled Hosseini
The House of the Spirits by Isabel Allende
Homegoing by Yaa Gyasi

As you read, annotate and think about the development of one main character. Your writing response will be a series of journal entries (10-15 of these entries, approximately one full paragraph long each) capturing the development of that main character. You might write these journal entries as though you are the character keeping a diary, or you could write your own responses to and perceptions of that character over the course of the story. In either case, consider using quotes in some of these entries. Make sure that you indicate quoted material with quotation marks and page numbers.

This writing will be due at the start of your second English class in the fall. In addition to this writing, there will be an in-class writing response based on your summer reading, which we'll discuss when you get to class.
