

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS MIDDLE AND UPPER SCHOOL (GRADES 6-11)

By getting to know your child, we are able to determine if the MPH program and environment are a good match for this particular stage in time. To get started, please follow these steps: **Submit an application** by visiting *mphschool.org/Admissions* and clicking on the blue "Apply Now" tab on the right side of the screen. A \$60 application fee is due at the time of submission. **Sign the top of the enclosed Records Release Form** and give it to the main office at your child's school. Records should be sent directly to the MPH Admissions Office. Sign the top of the enclosed Math and English Teacher Recommendations and give it to your child's current instructors. Forms should be returned directly to the MPH Admissions Office. Sign the top of the enclosed Personal Recommendation and give it to a person of your choosing who works with your child in a non-teaching role, such as a guidance counselor, principal, coach, pastor, or extracurricular supervisor. Forms should be returned directly to the MPH Admissions Office. Complete the enclosed Student Questionnaire. This form should be completed by your child in his or her own handwriting. To be considered for financial aid through the Flexible Tuition Program, complete the School and Student Services (SSS) Parents' Financial Statement at http://solutionsbysss.com/parents. A fee is charged by School & Student Services at the time of submission. Fee waivers for eligible families are available through SSS. Arrange for an MPH Shadow Day. The Office of Admissions will contact you to schedule your child's visit once the necessary application items have been received. Completed applications are reviewed at the end of each month, beginning in November and continuing until all available spaces have been reserved. Because spaces can be limited, we advise submitting the application items as early as possible for the best chance of securing a space in the fall class. Admissions offers are sent via standard mail, along with instructions to help you reserve your child's space for the following school year.
