

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS PREKINDERGARTEN AND KINDERGARTEN

We are so pleased you have decided to apply to Manlius Pebble Hill School. Our highly personalized admissions process helps us learn more about your child, assess his or her readiness for our program, and determine if the MPH environment is a good match for your child at this stage in his or her development. To get started, please follow these steps:

step	os:
	Submit an application by visiting <i>mphschool.org/Admissions</i> and clicking on the blue "Apply Now" tab on the right side of the screen. A \$60 application fee is due at the time of submission.
	Sign the top of the enclosed Teacher Assessment and give it to your child's current instructor or daycare provider. Forms should be returned directly to the MPH Admissions Office. This requirement is waived for children who are not currently enrolled in a daycare or program.
	If your child is currently in a program that provides progress reports, please submit a copy of his or her most recent report to the Office of Admissions. This requirement is waived for children who are not currently enrolled in a daycare or program.
	Arrange for your child's classroom visit and readiness assessment. The Office of Admissions will contact you to schedule your child's visit once the necessary application items have been received.
	Completed applications are reviewed at the end of each month, beginning in November and continuing until all available spaces have been reserved. Because spaces can be limited, we advise submitting your child's application items as early as possible for the best chance of securing a space in the fall class. Admissions offers are sent via standard mail, along with instructions to help you reserve your child's space for the following school year.
Elia	ihility: children must meet program age requirements and he fully notty-trained

Eligibility: children must meet program age requirements and be fully potty-trained to be eligible for admission to MPH Early Learning programs. Children applying for Prekindergarten must turn three by June 1, or four by December 1. Children applying for Kindergarten must turn five by December 1.
