

MPH Global: Orchestra Discovery

Description

Orchestra Discovery is an early beginner course designed for students ages three through five (with a caregiver), aimed towards cultivating a love of music while developing instrument readiness skills for future study. Highlights include building a "box" violin, learning aural and rhythmic skills through musical games and activities, and interactive instrument demonstrations. The class runs for 40 minutes, with approximately minutes of instructional time and 10 minutes of community time. All required supplies will be provided.

Mrs. Mirakian has completed long-term Suzuki teacher training and has a M.M. in Suzuki Pedagogy.
