Description

Composing for Film takes new and experienced student composers through the process of writing music for Film. At the end of the three-week course, students will have a fully polished score that they have composed for a film clip and a set of techniques they can apply to any new clip on their own. Monday classes are a lecture session, where students learn new techniques and concepts, and on Friday classes, students will have a session where the instructor and peers review their work. This course is taught by Alba S. Torremocha.
