Description

Mixed Level Acoustic Guitar is a group class focused on developing skills for song accompaniment in a variety of styles. The class is open to beginners who are familiar with basic open chords as well as more experienced players. Students will actively practice through mentored group participation, learning rhythm techniques, expanding their chord vocabulary, and more. Guest artist faculty Jeffrey Pepper Rodgers teaches the course. Students will receive a copy of his book/video *Beyond Strumming*.

Jeffrey Pepper Rodgers has combined his twin passions for words and music into a multifaceted career as a musician, author, and teacher. He is a grand prize winner of the John Lennon Songwriting Contest, founding editor of *Acoustic Guitar* magazine, and author of numerous books on guitar and songwriting. A “renowned guitar teacher” (*Boston Globe*), Rodgers has been a staff instructor at Ashokan Acoustic Guitar Camp and Lamb’s Retreat for Songwriters, and for over a decade he has taught courses on songwriting and creative nonfiction writing at Syracuse University.
