Description

Mixed Level Violin & Viola is a group class focused on developing overall musicianship. This class is open to students with at least six months of study. Through exercises, songs and games, students will work on posture, tone production, and ear training. Students will receive individualized attention on technique in a supportive community setting. Class repertoire is drawn from the Suzuki Method. Manlius Pebble Hill faculty member Teresa Mirakian teaches this course.

Teresa Mirakian is the Pre-K-12 strings teacher at Manlius Pebble Hill School and artistic director of MPH Global. Mrs. Mirakian has completed long-term Suzuki teacher training and has a M.M. in Suzuki Pedagogy. Past teaching positions include teaching strings in the Cambridge Public Schools and the Suzuki School of Newton (MA). As a violinist, Mrs. Mirakian has performed with Symphoria, the Granite State Symphony, the Boston Philharmonic, the Lexington Symphony, and the New Philharmonia Orchestra.
