# **Lower School Supply Lists**

#### MPH Lower School Bucket Hat Shield Guidelines (Pre-k, K and Grade 1)

- Pre-k will wear these when inside classrooms.
- Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> Grade students may wear these outside if children are engaging in closer play on playground equipment. (K and 1<sup>st</sup> Grade children will wear face coverings (masks) when inside campus buildings.)
- Fit/comfort/personal style (example: allowing your child to pick a favorite color) will help each child to comply with wearing these protective hats when children are inside. Please be sure to have your child practice wearing their hat at home before school begins.

### MPH Face Covering (Mask) Guidelines

- The most effective face covering (mask) is one that has a comfortable fit (snug but not tight) and is made of fabric that is tightly woven cotton or nonwoven polypropylene.
- o Fit/comfort/personal style (example: favorite color/design) will help each child to comply with wearing these face coverings when children are inside.
- Please be sure to have your child practice wearing their face covering at home before school begins. Teachers will work to get students outside for "mask breaks" as often as possible.
- o Fabric: 2 or 3 ply tightly woven cotton or nonwoven polypropylene.
- Please send your child to campus wearing their face covering (mask) and pack 1-2 extras with them in their bag.

#### Pre-K

- o Bucket Hat/Shield (Please see MPH LS Bucket Hat Shield Guidelines above)
- Tote bag or backpack
- o Extra VELCRO/no-tie sneakers in case of accidents (weather related/bathroom)
- All footwear should be slip-on/Velcro/no-tie
- o 1 box of tissues
- 1 pool/beach towel (for outside sitting/distancing)
- o 1 art smock or large used shirt that can be used as a smock (labeled)
- o 1 change of clothing in a Ziploc bag marked with your child's name
- o 1 water bottle (labeled): to be brought from school/home and washed daily
- Rain boots and raincoat (to stay at school)
- Nap Mat (washable):

- Please clearly label each item. Consider labels that will hold up in the dishwasher/washing machine (see example here).

## Kindergarten and Grade 1

- o Face covering (mask)(Please see MPH Face Covering Guidelines above)
- Bucket-hat/Shield (for closer outside play) (Please see MPH LS Bucket Hat Shield Guidelines above)
- All footwear should be slip-on/Velcro/no-tie
- 1 backpack (large enough to fit an 8 ½ x 11inch folder)
- o 1 box of tissues
- 1 pool/beach towel (for outside sitting/distancing)
- o 1 art smock or large used shirt that can be used as a smock (labeled)
- 1 change of clothing in a Ziploc bag marked with your child's name
- o 1 water bottle (labeled): to be brought from school/home and washed daily
- o Rain boots and raincoat (to stay at school)
- Headphones with a microphone
- Please clearly label each item. Consider labels that will hold up in the dishwasher/washing machine (see example here).

#### Grades 2 and 3

- Face covering (mask)(Please see MPH Face Covering Guidelines above)
- 1 pool/beach towel (for outside sitting/distancing)
- o 1 water bottle (labeled): to be brought from school/home and washed daily
- 1 pack of dry erase markers
- o 1 whiteboard eraser
- o 1 pack of pencils (mechanical or sharpened)
- 1 pack of 25 clear sheet protectors
- 1 one-inch 3-ring binder (End-of-Year Portfolio)

- o 2 durable pocket folders (Take Home Folder and Unfinished Work Folder)
- o 1 pair of earbuds/headphones with microphone
- o 2 composition notebooks (Math/Social Studies and Writing/Science)
- o Please clearly label each item with your child's name

#### **Grades 4 and 5 Bridge**

- Please clearly label the following supplies as necessary and remove items from their packaging at home.
  - o Face covering (mask) (Please see MPH Face Covering Guidelines above)
  - o 1 pool/beach towel (for outside sitting/distancing)
  - o 1 water bottle (labeled): to be brought from school/home and washed daily
  - 1 package of 12 colored pencils
  - o 1 package of fine line markers
  - o 1 sock/cloth to erase personal whiteboard
  - o 1 pair of earbuds/headphones with microphone (remove from packaging, labeled with child's name, in Ziplock bag)
- Place 1-2 of each of the below items inside the pencil box and extras (to restock during the year) inside a Ziplock bag for your child's backpack.
  - Supplies box (see example pictured)
  - o 24 Pencils
  - o 2 two-subject spiral notebooks with attached folders (see example pictured)
  - o 3 yellow highlighters
  - o 3 pens (blue/purple/green/or red)
  - o 3 pink erasers
  - o 3 glue sticks
  - o 1 pair of scissors
  - o 3 packs of sticky notes
  - o 6 bullet or fine point dry erase markers (any color)
