Marionette French Club

Class Description

In this afterschool club children will be introduced to language and culture through the art of puppetry, a traditional French art form. The focus of this class is to build a foundation of the major skills of communication for successful foreign language acquisition, interpretive, interpersonal and interpretive. The students will work collaboratively to create the marionettes, the stage, and a script, with a final show to be presented at the end of the course. A culturally relevant nut free afternoon snack will be provided.

*Depending on the number of students enrolled, it will be one play or several smaller plays created in small teams or pairs.

Students will be able to:

- Respond to greetings and introductions
- Learn vocabulary for adjectives, storybook characters, food, clothing and numbers 1-20
- Identify and use singular and plural personal pronouns with familiar vocabulary and context
- Identify and use present tense verbs with familiar vocabulary and context
- Identify and use the negative form with familiar vocabulary and context
- Identify and use prepositions with familiar vocabulary and context
