

Manlius Pebble Hill - Walking Trails

The MPH Walking Trails were created by the Middle School Leadership Team. The purpose of these walking trails is to limit congestion in the hallways between classes, which will help mitigate the spread of COVID-19. Students can choose to walk on the different trails - the Courtyard Trail, the Curtis Trail, the Foster Trail, and the CEL Trail - reducing the number of people crowding in the hallways. Each trail has a different distance and time, so students should choose trails carefully in order to fit their schedule. Some trails continue outside, providing a time for students to take a mask break, breathe fresh air, and spend time with friends. These outdoor trails will require teacher permission.

Here are the descriptions of the walking trails. Please view the attached maps, as well.

Courtyard Trail (Yellow):

The Courtyard trail travels around the STEAM park's perimeter, through McNeil, to Bradlee, and into the phoenix center, passing the gym and the former library with a cut through the STEAM park. Walk with a friend or on your own!

Distance: 500 ft

Approximate time: 3:05 mins

CEL Trail (Blue)

The CEL trail is a longer trail around the middle parking lot, passing the CEL and the sidewalk by the upper field. Since it is outside the perimeter of the buildings, it should be done with a teacher/adult. Watch for traffic in the driveway!

Distance: 982 ft

Approximate time: 3:31 mins

Foster Trail (Green): (8th Grade)

The Foster trail is a trail around the school perimeter. It travels between the gym and the tennis courts, continuing behind the former library and behind lower Amos, to connect with the CEL trail. Since it is outside the perimeter of the buildings, it should be done with a teacher/adult.

Distance: 1,535 ft

Approximate time: 6:40 mins

Curtis Trail (Red): (7th Grade)

The Curtis trail travels outside the McNeil lobby and connects with the CEL trail. It continues around the outside perimeter of the CEL building and connects back with the CEL trail by the upper field. This trail also requires a teacher/adult to accompany you, as it continues outside and travels along the road. Watch for traffic in the driveway!

Distance: 1,357 ft

Approximate time: 4:46
