From AI, Model UN, Math League, to Bluegrass Fiddle, Unscripted Improv, Volunteers in Action, and Nature Trail Maintenance, students explore interests, discover new talents, and grow confident as creators, teammates, and leaders. Faculty advisors mentor small groups, but clubs are student-driven: learners pitch ideas, plan events, publish magazines, build robots, launch sustainability projects, and perform on stage and in competition.
